Our Commitment

Jetz Netball Club (JNC) is a not-for-profit organisation within the southern suburbs of Perth Western Australia. Our club is a netball club catering for players aged 7 – adult. We play as an affiliated club with Netball WA within the Southern Districts Netball Association.

Our fees are paramount to what we can offer our players; we aim to provide coaching, safe up to date equipment, development for coaches, players and umpires, end of season presentation event etc.

Registration

- Online registrations will open in December/January and close in February
- Late registrations will form a pre-season waitlist and if there are positions in existing teams or coaches available to take additional teams, the club will try and facilitate the late submission of teams. It is at the discretion of the Grading and Team Selection Sub Committee, given our associations may not facilitate our requests.
- The teams within an age group are dependent upon coaches and if there is no coach then there is no guarantee that there will be a team available.
- If there is no position on a team, then the player will be notified and placed on the wait list.
 - At this point any fees paid will be refunded.
 - Players are welcome to try and register at another club.
- Registrations are first in first served and will be recorded as such.
- It is the members' responsibility to contact the Registrar if they have any issues regarding registration or need to organise registration outside of the dates set aside.
- Registration is to be completed online through PlayHQ and fees to paid at this time.

Payment of Fees

All queries regarding fees are to be directed to the Club Treasurer.

Fees are reviewed and set each year and are based upon the following factors -

- Fees payable by JNC to Southern Districts Netball Association of which is divided into 2 parts.
- Southern Districts Netball Association
- Netball WA

The balance remains with JNC for costs at club level such as equipment, umpiring, coach, player development, and trophies. There is currently no Fundraising Levy included in the fee structure and any fundraising conducted by the club is in addition to funds received as fees. These funds are used to continue to provide our players and members opportunities at club level and contribute to funding the end of season windup

PAYMENT OF FEES

ALL FEES ARE TO BE PAID AT REGISTRATION ONLINE.

If you are not in a position to pay your fees in full at registration, you will need to contact the club Treasurer to discuss your needs. It is the responsibility of the registrant to ensure that these discussions are held before the registration date.

Uniforms MUST be paid in full when ordering, as the club must order and pay for new uniform items prior to the commencement of each season.

Kidsport



Jetz Netball Club continue to offer KIDSPORT. This is a local government scheme where clubs receive \$300 per child per annum funding for eligible players. All information is available at the Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries website.

In the case that you intend to apply for Kidsport you will be required to do the following -

- Submit a KIDSPORT online application, ensuring it is registered under Jetz Netball Club
- Complete club registration online
- Provide the Club Treasurer with your Kidsport Voucher code

At registration you will be required to pay for the balance of fees (net of KidSport funding) to the club

Payment Options

All payments are to be made through PlayHQ with their own imposed fees. (refer to their website).

PlayHQ has multiple payment options which will be available at checkout.

Withdrawing a Registration

We understand that there are occasions when a member may need to withdraw from the club. This process has been included in this policy. The process for withdrawals will be as follows. Please note JNC has a \$60/per player NON-REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT from 2023 onwards.

Please note that in the event that JNC cannot provide a team for your player a full refund including all fees and costs (excluding any uniform items that have been personalised with your player's name) will be refunded in a timely manner.

Withdrawals Prior to Club Registration at Southern Districts Netball Association

- All withdrawals must be forwarded to the Registrar as soon as possible IN WRITING.
- At this point members will receive a full refund of all monies, including (New/unworn dresses only) minus a \$60 per player NON-REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT.

Withdrawals After Club Registration at Southern Districts Netball Association but Prior to Start of The Season

 All withdrawals must be forwarded to the registrar as soon as possible IN WRITING. All members will receive a full refund of all monies, including dresses (New/unworn dresses only) minus a \$60 per player NON-REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT, and any cancellation fee imposed by Southern Districts Netball Association and Netball WA.

Withdrawals Once Season Commenced

- All withdrawals must be forwarded to the registrar as soon as possible IN WRITING.
- NO REFUND IS GIVEN.
- Uniform is NOT refundable.

In extenuating circumstances, such as injury which requires a player to withdraw from JNC prior to the commencement of the season; a member can apply in writing to have all fees including the NON-REFUNDABLE portion reimbursed. Requests must be made in writing to the club registrar on registrar@jetznetball.onmicrosoft.com. This will be discussed and decided upon by the current Executive Committee of JNC. In the event of an injury/illness a valid medical certificate will need to be sighted.

Changes to Teams

Any changes to team lists, including transfer of players between teams, withdrawing of players from teams or additions of players is at the discretion of the JNC Registrar in consultation with the Committee.

- Addition of Players
 - Can occur at any time. Please note that single-game vouchers paid prior to registration will reduce the registration fee.
- Withdrawal of Players
 - See above descriptions

Transfer of Players

- Any transfer of players once registration with the Association has occurred, will incur an administration fee applied by SDNA of which JNC will cover if the transfer is at the request of the club.
- If the transfer is at the request of the Parent/Member, then the administration fee applied by SDNA will be passed onto the parent/member who is responsible for payment.

No Pay No Play

If players are not considered financial (all fees paid) by the third game of the season those players will NOT be permitted to play in games until all fees are paid. The player is permitted to train with their team.
